<u>Homework</u> – Using Number Lines to Show Fractions

<u>Directions</u>: Draw a number line and partition, or divide it into eighths. Label the following fractions on the number line:  $\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $\frac{7}{8}$ ,  $\frac{3}{4}$ ,  $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $\frac{5}{8}$ 

Use a number line to solve the problems:

1. At the playground,  $\frac{4}{8}$  of the children went to the swings.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the children played in the sandbox. Where were most of the children playing? Draw two number lines to show these fractions.

2. I want to share my birthday cake with 5 people including myself. Draw a number line to show how I should share my cake equally. Could I partition differently so everyone gets the same amount? Explain.
